- 1) Bylaws and Directory –Awaiting update from attorney, on CWEA from a 501(c)(6) to a 501(c)(3), a tax-exempt non-profit.
- 2) Budget/Finance A "reserves" account within QuickBooks has been set up for adding a minimum of \$5,000.00 a year until such time as ½ year of expenses are accumulated as agreed upon by the Executive Committee on August 13, 2012. Past President DeBoda to provide a budget with those responsible named and the income and expenses will be reviewed monthly.
- 3) Chesapeake Tri-Association update Ted DeBoda briefed the Board the Chesapeake Tri-Association Conference, Inc. is now a corporation and will incorporate three directors with each association responsible for appointing their individual to serve in this capacity. The main function of the three (3) directors will be to facilitate finances and facilitate appropriate business practices. Sandra Pfau Englund has been retained as legal counsel, to assist in items remaining, which include drafting Bylaws, etc. A face-to-face meeting was held in DC, July 13, 2012 to answer questions, as how often the board needs to meet, and administrative responsibilities. Each association has equally shared in formation costs. The new entity name is, Chesapeake Tri-Association, Incorporated. A new checking account will be set up, taken out from under the CSAWWA umbrella, when appropriately advised by Attorney Englund.

Motion No. 68-12: Motion made by Paul Sayan, seconded by Jeff Cantwell, appointing Ted DeBoda as CWEA's Director to the Chesapeake Tri-Association, Inc. and continue as Director until the 2013 post-Chesapeake Tri-Association Conference and re-evaluate each year at this time. Motion carried.
