**Chesapeake Bay Program Tells a Cautionary Success Story About Bay Health**

**The Chesapeake Bay Program's annual report includes climate change impacts for the first time**

The Chesapeake Bay Program's annual science-based snapshot, Bay Barometer: Health and Restoration in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed 2017-18, continues to report encouraging signs of resilience throughout the ecosystem, but reminds us that we still have a long way to go in meeting our ultimate restoration goals. Now, for the first time, this assessment also tracks the impact that a changing climate has on the Chesapeake Bay watershed. This year's Bay Barometer tells a story of resilience—the highest water quality score since monitoring began more than 30 years ago and a record-breaking abundance of underwater grasses—but there still remains a lot of work to do.
