# **CWEA Public Outreach Committee**

## Seeking a committee chair and Stockholm Junior Water Prize Judges

The Public Outreach Committee Chair duties generally include:

- Sign up for science fair judging (generally occurs in Feb March timeframe
- Solicit volunteers to participate in science fair judging (usually 1 2 judges needed per science fair)
- The winners of these science fairs will be eligible for the Stockholm Junior Water Prize (SJWP); once these candidates are identified, the Public Outreach Chair will coordinate with Traci to provide funding to the families to cover their airfare

At the moment, there is also an immediate need for 2 judges to participate in the SJWP judging. Judging is virtual and entails reviewing and scoring student project submissions. This will occur towards the end of May/early June and in the past we've had around 20 projects to review and score.

# Career Coaches NEEDED for our EPA Grant winning program!



### The Baltimore City YH20 Career Mentoring Program

Industry professionals will volunteer to serve as one-on-one Career Coaches to young adults enrolled in the program:

- Career Coaches will each be matched with a youth program participant with whom they will communicate on a weekly basis, either in-person, virtually, or by phone, email, or text.
- During these conversations, Career Coaches will talk with their mentees about their progress in the
  program, discuss their strengths and skills, gauge their career interests, talk about specific jobs within
  the industry they may be well suited for, and answer any questions they have about the field, etc.
- There will also be opportunities for all Career Coaches and Program Participants to get together as a group occasionally during the months of May, June, or July. (Virtually or in-person)
- Time commitment is 1 2 hours per week depending on the level of communication the Career Coach
  commits to give their mentee.


